	(IAA), Baku Malyalee Association (BMA) and Tamil Sangam, which
	work in close association with the Embassy of India in Baku. They
	regularly hold social events to celebrate major Indian festivals and events.
	The Indian community which is in the 4th/5th place in Azerbaijan, in terms
	of numerical strength, is very active both professionally and socially and
	has integrated well with the local population.
